## **Code of Conduct**

### **Our expectation of the student:**

- They are ready (goggles & caps on) and on time for their lesson
- They listen to their instructors and follow instructions to the best of their ability
- They respect and cooperate with other children in the class
- They behave in an acceptable manner before, during and after the lessons
- They abide by all Aquatic Centre rules
- They aim to do their best at all times during the lesson

### **Our expectations of parents/caregivers:**

- They support the instructors in their work with the swimmer
- They support the instructors, on the rare occasion if asked to remove their child from the lesson for behaviour reasons
- They do not confront the instructors in any verbal way at anytime
- Any issues regarding the lessons, are brought to the attention of the Swim School Supervisor in order to resolve them

### **Our expectations of the Instructors:**

- The health and safety of all swimmers in each class is of utmost priority
- They prepare for and conduct each lesson to the best of their knowledge and training
- They start and finish lessons on time
- They display a professional attitude and image at all times
- They report back to the Swim School Supervisor on the progress of their swimmers
- They take short written notes and plan their next lesson ahead of time

## **Guidelines for behaviour management**

1. Verbal warning
2. Child is given appropriate timeout on the side of class or under instructor supervision
3. Child removed from lesson
4. Any child biting, hitting or kicking will be removed from that days lesson immediately
