- file with the DLC prior to hearing, the grounds of that interest (if not already notified)
- advise if they intend to make submissions or give evidence at the hearing
- provide <u>four</u> copies of the typed statement of the evidence and submissions to be tendered at the hearing for the exclusive use of the Committee
- provide additional copies to be made available for other parties at the hearing

Please note that disclosure is an ongoing obligation and evidence should be disclosed as soon as possible. The Committee must conduct the hearing observing the principles of natural justice, which require that all parties to the hearing have a reasonable opportunity to prepare for it. It is noted, however, that oral evidence may be presented during a public hearing to supplement written materials that have already been circulated.

If such persons do not then appear in person or by counsel, the matter may be heard and determined in their absence.
