

## SELWYN DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE ANNUAL REPORT TO ARLA 2017

#### 1. Overview of District Licensing Committee workload:

#### DLC's structure and personnel

Selwyn District's agency consists of two Commissioners, six Committee members, two of which are new to the Committee, one Secretary, a chief Alcohol Licensing Inspector, one backup Licensing Inspector and administration staff.

The DLC has contracted services in the administration and Licensing Inspector's roles.

#### **Staff Training**

A DLC seminar invite was extended out to all neighbouring Territorial Authorities by the Waimakariri District Council. The Seminar was led my Alistair Lawn in conjunction with the Waimakariri DLC members. Selwyn Licensing Inspectors attended along with the Administration staff and new DLC members. The Seminar was a great way to induct new personnel into their roles and was recognised that the seminar would be a great training tool for those already part of the Committee or joining as new members. The Seminar was very interactive, which utilised all members strengths using role play to develop skills and understanding of the DLC's role in the community.

Ashburton District Council hosted a webinar which illustrated how a DLC should operate, what responsibilities a DLC has and how decisions are made. The Selwyn DLC was invited to attend and the Commissioner, Secretary, DLC members and Administration Staff took the opportunity for further training and this created a platform for communications between districts and allowed both TA's to discuss processes and procedures.

#### Change in Business

There has been an increase in workloads from an administrative and Inspection perspective, this is consistent with the high level of growth within Selwyn District with new premises seeking licences.

#### **DLC Meetings and Hearings**

Weekly meetings are held with the Licensing Inspector and administration staff. Monthly meetings are held with the Chairperson, Secretary and administrative staff to discuss forthcoming Hearings and ongoing issues.

Tri agency meetings take place monthly to obtain a collaborated approach.

The District Licensing Committee have held four Hearings over the past year; three of which were for the same applicant. The applicant is the Licensee of a local Tavern based in Kirwee. The first hearing was an application for a Special Licence. The licence was granted by the DLC with additional conditions. The second Hearing for this applicant was for an Onand Off Licence and a Managers Certificate. The Hearing was adjourned so the applicant could present the Committee with specific requirements and further evidence to illustrate suitability. Based on this further evidence the Hearing was reheard and resulted in the applicant receiving both the On and Off licence's. The Managers Certificate is pending subject to the applicant completing six months of further training, which includes having an experienced mentor working in the industry.

The final hearing was for a Liquorland Off Licence application based in West Melton. Several objections were received in response to this application as the location of the bottle store was to be based opposite the local primary school. We had one objector speak to his submission who represented the local school. The committee granted the licence with specific conditions that satisfied both parties.

#### 2. Agencies Initiatives:

Expiry reminder letters are sent to all licence holders and managers certificate holders two months prior to the expiry date of the licence or certificate, along with renewal forms. Annual fee invoices are now sent out at the same time. A bring-up reminder system has also been implemented to ensure that if a licensed premises renewal application has not been received before the expiry date, that the office and Inspector are aware of this before it expires. This ensures that no premises can operate unlicensed at any time.

The Selwyn District Council Alcohol Licensing webpage is working extremely well with positive feedback from licensees. This webpage allows the public notice of On, Off and Club licences to be published online. Notice of Public Hearings and Public Hearing decisions are also notified on the website.

#### 3. Local Alcohol Policy

The Council's Provisional Local Alcohol Policy has been reconsidered by the Alcohol Licensing and Regulatory Authority who are satisfied the provisions of the policy are not unreasonable in light of the object of the Act.

Accordingly, all appeals against the policy have been resolved of in their entirety.

Pursuant to Section 87 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 the policy has been adopted and creases to be provisional.

The policy (apart from the provisions relating to maximum trading hours which effect licensed premises) came into effect on 24 April 2017.

The provisions of the policy relating to the maximum trading hours for licensed premises, came into effect on 31 July 2017.

#### 4. Current Legislation

Administration workloads have increased significantly; due to all applications and reports being sent to the Commissioner for a final decision before a licence can be issued. This also adds time to the process.

The number of supporting documents required for On, Off and Club licence applications under The Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act has often been criticized by applicants, as more documents are now required. This seems to be an ongoing issue especially for the applicants renewing.

## 5. Any other matters the Agency might wish to draw to the attention of the Authority:

Representation will be made at the New Zealand Institute of Liquor Licensing Inspectors in Wellington. This conference will be patronised by DLC Inspectors, the Police and Medical Officers of Health.

Applications for Temporary Authorities should be able to be determined by the Chairperson sitting alone. It is suggested the Section 191 (3) of the Act to be amended to include Temporary Authorities.

Currently hard copies of completed application form, decisions and issued licences are set to ARLA monthly with the monthly return. A recommendation would be to file these electronically monthly.
