



SELWYN DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE **ANNUAL REPORT TO ARLA 2014**

1. Overview of District Licensing Committee workload:

- **DLC's structure and personnel**

Selwyn's agency consists of two Commissioners, five Committee members, one Secretary, a chief alcohol licensing inspector, one alcohol licensing inspector and administration staff.

The DLC has contracted services in the administration, secretary and alcohol licensing inspector's roles.

- **Staff Training**

CPTED training, and in house training by the Commissioner for chairs and members has been undertaken. The alcohol licensing inspector, secretary and administration staff all attended LG training prior to the new act coming in to place.

- **Change in Business**

There has been a significant increase in workloads from an administration and Inspectors prospective.

- **DLC Meetings and Hearings**

- Weekly meetings are held with the Chair, Alcohol Licensing Inspector and Secretary.
- Quarterly meetings with the Police and Ministry of Health take place, with the Agency recording minutes, matters for attention and

controversial applications seeking more of a collaborated on approach and input.

- The District Licensing Committee have held three Hearings, two for Temporary Authorities and one opposed new On licence application. The On Licence was declined, and has since been appealed. The application is now before ALAR for determination.

2. Agencies Initiatives:

- Expiry reminder letters are sent to all licence holders and managers certificate holders one month prior to the expiry date to the licence certificate, along with renewal forms. Annual fee invoices are now sent out at the same time.
- Collaborating with other neighbouring TA's to reach a customer friendly approach to Fees for special licenses that also adheres to the object of the Act.
- At all renewal applications, interviews are now conducted on site by all three agencies, with the Inspector producing an extensive photo montage for further reference and clarity of licensed premises going forward.

3. Local Alcohol Policy

- The Council agreed to develop a LAP at the 12 December 2012 Council meeting and to have a provisional LAP before the 2013 elections. The Council followed the process under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 to prepare a LAP and worked with the Police, Medical Officers of Health and the licensing inspector for Selwyn. Initial feedback was obtained through a range of methods, including through emails, surveys and meetings with stakeholders, community boards and Councillors. Two short surveys were undertaken to obtain young people's opinions of alcohol issues.
- The special consultative procedure was undertaken in June 2013. Sixty-seven submissions were received including submissions from the

retail and the hospitality industry, the New Zealand Police, public health providers and Selwyn community boards and committees, local licence holders (such as sports clubs and taverns) and the public.

- The Provisional policy was endorsed at the 11 September 2014 council meeting and publicly notified on 28 January 2014. It was appealed by Foodstuffs South Island Ltd, Progressive Enterprises Limited, The Mill Retail Holdings, Independent Liquor, Hospitality Association of New Zealand and the Lincoln Golf Club.
- "The Council is awaiting further direction from the Authority."

4. Current Legislation

- Administration workloads have increased significantly; due to all applications and reports being sent to the Commissioner for a final decision before a licence can be issued.
- Having to obtain a waiver for Special Licences received outside the required 20 working days is a very time consuming process, which actually adds more processing time to the application.
- Risk ratings for licensed premises is working well although on renewal when premises vary their license conditions after being interviewed by the inspector and change category the implications of increasing/decreasing fees can be confusing and difficult for monthly reporting and annual fee collection.
- Special Licenses and more particularly understanding the fees regulations for special licenses has caused a number of difficulties for this TA. We imagine that the regulations were supposed to provide some clarity around fees, categories and risk for special licenses, both On and Off site specials. We have found the opposite to be true with ambiguous wording around the word "Event" in the Regulations. We don't think that the intention of the Act was to make small Cellar door Off licenses pay large fees for large events when their stands are small

and low risk but the use of the word “Event “ in the fees regulations causes a number interpretation issues for both councils and customers.

7. Any other matters the Agency might wish to draw to the attention of the Authority:

- Representation was made at the New Zealand Institute of Liquor Licensing Inspectors in Wellington. This conference was well patronised by DLC Inspectors, the Police and Medical Officers of Health.
