We are writing to let you know that we are preparing to upgrade to the intersection of Rolleston Drive and Tennyson Street, which will involve replacing the current roundabout with traffic signals.

We are planning to advertise for construction tenders from August and construction is expected to take 16 weeks, commencing in November 2021.

As well as installing traffic signals, the upgrade involves new road pavement construction and replacing the existing water main and sewer main pipes through the intersection with larger pipes as future proofing. We will also be piping the remaining section of open water race on Tennyson St, south of the intersection.

The project includes upgrading Rolleston Drive, west of Tennyson Street, up to the Rolleston Community Centre. This upgrade is to change this section of Rolleston Drive to a lower speed environment on the approaches to the future town centre entrance and will include new planted median islands and paved footpaths.

The attached general layout plan for the intersection upgrade and Rolleston Drive Upgrade is attached.

While impacts to traffic movements, including road closures will likely be unavoidable during certain stages of construction, we will be putting a high emphasis on minimising these impacts and we will ensure access to businesses is maintained throughout construction.

We will be in contact once we have a contractor on board and will at that stage be able to confirm timeframes and provide more specific details of the impacts you may expect from these works.
