Investigation work

On 12 and 13 December 2024 between 9am - 2:30pm, we'll be doing investigation work at the intersection of Burnham School Road and Dunns Crossing Road to confirm underground services and ground conditions.

This work involves digging a small trench in the road. Once we have the information we need, we then reinstate the road surface and repeat this process at points along the investigation route.

 Stop/Go traffic management will be in place at the intersection of Burnham School Road and Dunns Crossing Road while we do this work.

Please follow all signs and instructions from our crew.

Installing the new power cable


Between 2 - 25 January 2025 the intersection of Burnham School Road and Dunns Crossing Road will be closed as we work to install new underground power cables to strengthen our electricity network.

Our crew will be working over the school holidays to minimise the impact on the local school.

These cables are being installed in preparation for construction of the new West Rolleston Zone Substation. We're installing new underground power cables to connect to the new substation to increase the capacity of the power network in Rolleston.

We've nearly completed the first of these cables along Dunns Crossing Road, between Burnham School Road and Brookside Road.

Traffic management

To safely do this work:

- Burnham School Road and Dunns Crossing Road will be closed at the intersection near West Rolleston Primary School.
- Access to Dunns Crossing Road from SH1
 Main South Road will be closed. Access from Dunns Crossing Road to SH1 remains open.
- Detour routes will be sign posted.
- Access to the Pines Resource Recovery Park is maintained via detour routes.

Please follow all signs and instructions from our crew.

We're working with the school and preschool on access during the works.

Hours of work

In January, the crew will generally work during the day between the hours of **7am - 6pm, Monday - Saturday**.

Rubbish collection

Your rubbish will be collected as normal. Please bring your rubbish bins out to the kerb.

On street parking

There will be no on street parking available where we are working.

Safety reminder

To do this work safely, we need to have traffic management in place. The safety of our crew and the community is a priority, so please follow the traffic management and instructions from our crew. Our crew are there to help. Please talk with them if you have specific access needs, or have any questions.

How we install the cable

The cables are installed in a trench in the road. We then install ducts, which are plastic pipes that we pass the cable through. Once the ducts are in place, we will reinstate the road surface and reopen the road. Later, we will thread the cable through the ducts.

Installing ducts allows us to speed up the cable laying process and reduce the impacts of traffic management.
