## Darfield and Kirwee to Pines WWTP Pipeline Construction

<b>What</b>	Construction of the new Darfield and Kirwee to Pines WWTP wastewater pipeline.
<b>Where</b>	Aylesbury Road – From SH1 to Two Chain Road
<b>When</b>	From Monday 14 February to May 2022
<b>Why</b>	To connect the upcoming Darfield and Kirwee reticulated wastewater systems to the Pines Wastewater Treatment Plant

We are writing to let you know that Selwyn District Council will be carrying out works in your area as part of the construction of a new wastewater pipeline between Darfield and the Pines Wastewater Treatment Plant.

The work will require that Aylesbury Road is reduced to one way between State Highway 1 and Two Chain Road. There will be a detour in place and traffic management on Aylesbury Road and surrounding roads.

The works will be carried out in sections of up to 300 meters. When the works are outside your property, access to your driveway could be restricted, please speak to the work staff and they will organise for you to get in or out of your property safely. We will try and keep traffic, dust and noise to a minimum. Your water and wastewater supply won't be affected.

This is the first of two stages of TM that will be implemented on Aylesbury Road, a second notice will be circulated before the next change.
