We are writing to give you an update on our current works on Courtenay Road and SH73.

We have installed the main wastewater pipeline along SH73 and are now moving onto the next stage of the project which involves installing the pipe under the railway lines on Courtenay Road.

For this stage of work Courtenay Road will be fully closed (24hrs/day) from the rail lines to SH73 until early September. Access to properties on Courtenay Road will be via Bealey Road/Courtenay Road detour. Courtenay Road between Miles Road and the rail lines will be fully open. There will be a pedestrian access from Courtenay Road to SH73.

In the final stage of the project we will be installing the pipeline under SH73 at the pumpstation site in Kirwee. This will happen once Courtenay Road is open but there will be again a traffic light setup on SH73.
