## Darfield and Kirwee to Pines WWTP Pipeline Construction

<b>What</b>	Construction of the new Darfield and Kirwee to Pines WWTP wastewater pipeline.
<b>Where</b>	Intersection of SH1 and Aylesbury Road/Burnham Road
<b>When</b>	From 6.00pm Sunday 15 May to 6.00am Monday 16 May
<b>Why</b>	To connect the upcoming Darfield and Kirwee reticulated wastewater systems to the Pines Wastewater Treatment Plant

We are writing to let you know that Selwyn District Council will be carrying out works in your area as part of the construction of a new wastewater pipeline between Darfield and the Pines Wastewater Treatment Plant.

Nightwork is required for one night to carry out work on the State Highway. This cannot be done during the day as it requires the State Highway to be reduced to one lane with Stop Go in place. The current one way systems in place on Aylesbury Road and Burnham Road will remain the same.

Additional measures will be put in place to keep noise at your property to a minimum including installing sound barriers around the work site and through work practices. Your water and wastewater supply won't be affected.

If the nightworks on Sunday night get postponed because of weather or any other unforeseen circumstance, it will be completed on the next available night. A further letter drop will be done if the date changes.
