Additional Notes to Applicants

1. Permits continued after October 2001 subject to resource consent conditions.
2. The water race that irrigation is proposed to be taken from is of sufficient size so there will not be detrimental effect to downstream users.
3. Non refundable application fee of \$300 including GST.
4. Properties must be currently rated for stock water.
5. If the application is successful
 - a. An irrigation agreement will be signed between Selwyn District Council and the landowner
 - b. A flow monitoring device shall be installed at all abstraction points to Council's requirements before irrigation commences.
6. The proposed irrigation take must be over 5 l/second and based on the 0.6 l/sec/ha formula (except in special circumstances at the discretion of the Asset Manager). The proposed irrigation take must be for an established business or evidence to support the establishment of a business.
7. That the water shall be conveyed to the applicable properties via reticulation and other structures to the approval of the Asset Manager.
8. Yearly charge noted in Annual Plan (refer to the Annual Plan for the charge)
9. Based on river restrictions there is no guarantee of water for irrigation use
10. No additional water will be made available over what is required for the normal operation of the Paparua water race scheme.
11. This information provided will be used to consider your application and assist in the management of the water race system.
