



Notes:

- 1) Clay or bentonite lining 75–100mm
- 2) Plastic liner line with crusher dust or sand 25mm
- 3) If over 400mm deep, classified as an irrigation pond and only permitted in the Paparua scheme upon application. Must be fenced with hot wire fencing or permanent sheep fencing including gate access for maintenance and cleaning purposes.

Notes:

- 1) A pond is an area of water being used for purposes other than a watering place for stock or for irrigation storage
- 2) Ponds are permitted subject to the following conditions:
 - a) Size restricted to 100m².
 - b) Maximum depth of water shall be 400mm.
 - c) Separate inlet and outlet pipes to water race.
 - d) Inlet and outlet pipes with valves shall be 100mm diameter (nominal).
 - e) Shall have no detrimental effect on downstream users.
 - f) The pond must be isolated from the water race system.
 - g) A water loss test must be carried out in consultation with a Council representative before the pond is fully functional.
 - h) The pond must be lined with suitable material such as clay to minimize water loss and/or potential leakage.
 - i) No detrimental effect on water quality shall occur.
 - j) Construction and maintenance shall be to the satisfaction of the Asset Manager.
 - k) Property must be rated for stock water.
 - l) Non refundable permit fee of \$200 (excluding GST).
 - m) Where a proposed pond is felt to have detrimental effect on the water race scheme then permissions for the pond will be declined.
 - n) Permission for continued use of the pond may be withdrawn if Conditions e, f,g,h and i are not meet.
