NOTES:

Council will allow a singular controlled connection point, which must be Metered and protected with an RPZ. The permit applicant will bear the cost of meter and RPZ installation.

The Applicant is required to provide a photographic reference, clearly showing the Meter Number, Start Read and RPZ Protection.

Other Conditions of Use apply.

Conditions of Approval:

1. All takes will abide by the Council Water Supply Bylaw 2008 (amended 2018).
2. On each development site, SDC will allow a singular controlled connection point, this must be metered and protected with an RPZ. Permit applicant will bear the cost of meter and RPZ installation.
3. All takes may be inspected on a daily basis to ensure the ongoing integrity of the temporary connection with regards to the Council Water Supply Bylaw 2008 (amended 2018).
4. Permit holder must provide meter number (and photograph), Start Read (and photograph) and agree to send in monthly reads by email (with photograph) to water.services@selwyn.govt.nz and agree to pay all water use charges at the rate of \$0.46 per m³.
5. Extraction use will be restricted to 9am – 4pm, Monday to Friday, no exceptions.
6. If any connections are found or identified over and above the agreed singular connection point, all agreements to extract water will be removed and no further extraction considered.
7. Should demand on the public infrastructure reach increased levels, Council reserves the right to either suspend use or consider further restrictions on extraction.
8. Permit holders are also to provide full details of any alternative water sources being deployed on the Development site.
9. Extraction permits will be reviewed again on 01 March 19.
10. The permit is non-transferable and a copy of the permit has to be maintained by the operators during the time of drawing water.
11. If you currently have an approved extraction permit you will need to reconfirm acceptance of the above conditions 1-10, to continue through this summer period to 01 March 19.
