SPECIAL ORDER

SELWYN DISTRICT COUNCIL TRAFFIC BYLAW NO. 1 2000

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Local Government Act 1974 and the Transport Act 1962, and of all other powers and provisions contained or implied in any other statute or regulation enabling it in that behalf, the Selwyn District Council hereby resolves by way of a Special Order to make and ordain this bylaw.

1. DEFINITIONS

In this bylaw unless the context otherwise requires:

Traffic Sign means a regulatory sign complying with the provisions of Part XII of the Traffic Regulations 1976 and the Fourth Schedule thereto.

Provided that traffic domes or letters of other indicators placed upon roads by the Council for the direction of traffic shall not be deemed to be traffic signs.

Vehicle means a contrivance equipped with wheels, tracks or revolving runners upon which it moves or is moved and includes a skateboard, inline skates (roller-blades) and roller-skates; but does not include:

- (a) A perambulator or pushchair;
- (b) A shopping or sporting trundler;
- (c) A wheelbarrow or hand-trolley;
- (d) A child's toy, including a tricycle and a bicycle, provided, in either case, no road wheel (including any tyre) has a diameter exceeding 355 mm;
- (e) A pedestrian-controlled lawn mower;
- (f) Any pedestrian-controlled agricultural machinery not propelled by mechanical power;
- (g) Any article of furniture; or
- (h) Any invalid wheelchair.

2. ONE WAY TRAFFIC

- (a) Vehicles on the roads, or the parts of the road, designated in the First Schedule to this bylaw shall travel only in the direction for that road.
- (b) Any restrictions to travel in once specified direction only shall be subject to the erection of traffic signs.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Kildare Terrace, Lincoln

On that part of Kildare Street, Lincoln between the front entrance to the Lincoln Medical Centre and the intersection with South Belt (for a distance of 225 metres) traffic shall travel in a southerly direction only.

This resolution was passed at a meeting of the Selwyn District Council held on 8th March 2000 and confirmed at a subsequent meeting of the said Council on 12th April 2000.
