#### Consultation on speed limit changes

Selwyn District Council is seeking community feedback on proposed speed limit changes, which would introduce lower speed limits on a number of roads across Selwyn district.

The speed limit changes are included in the Schedule to the Council's Speed Limits Bylaw 2016. Under the bylaw, speed limits can be changed way of Council resolution.

These changes have been proposed following a review of speed limits across the district, and reflect the growth in population and traffic volumes many Selwyn townships. The roads reviewed included those requested by residents, local committees and councillors, as well as others identified by staff. Crash location data has also been used to help identify areas where changes may be needed.

#### The proposals include:

- extending 50 and 70 km/hr zones on the outskirts of several townships
- extending or introducing 80 km/hr limits on rural roads adjoining the Christchurch city boundary, and extending out to Tai Tapu, Lincoln and Rolleston

Townships where lower speed limits are proposed to be extended include:

- Castle Hill
- Leeston
- Lincoln
- Prebbleton
- Rolleston and Rolleston Izone
- West Melton


#### Consultation is now open
