Introduction

The purpose of the register of members' pecuniary interests per the Local Government (Pecuniary Interests Register) Amendment Act 2022 is to record members' interests so as to provide transparency and to strengthen public trust and confidence in local government processes and decision-making.

- 10. Have you travelled to any country (other than New Zealand) where your travel and accommodation costs were not paid for in full and/or a member of your family? (In this question, 'family' means the members' spouse, partner, parent, grandparent, child, stepchild, foster child, grandchild, or sibling.)
- 11. Have you received any gift (other than from a family member, unless you consider that gift should be disclosed taking into account the purpose of the members' pecuniary interests register) that:
 - has an estimated market value in New Zealand of over \$500; or
 - when combined with all other gifts from the same donor, have a total estimated market value in New Zealand of over \$500?
 - In this question: 'gift' includes hospitality and donations in cash or kind, but excludes expenses, and 'family' means the members' spouse, partner, parent, grandparent, child, stepchild, foster child, grandchild, or sibling.
- 12. Have you received any payment for an activity which you are involved, excluding:
 - any salary or allowance paid to you under the Remuneration Authority Act 1977 or the Local Government Act 2002
 - any payment received from an interest that has already been disclosed in this return; or
 - any payment made in respect of any activity that you ceased to be involved in before becoming a member?
