The Chair, Mr J Morten welcomed everyone to the meeting.

CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES

Minutes of the Meeting of the Malvern Community Board held in the Darfield Library & Service Centre Meeting Room on Monday 22 March 2021

Mrs Pascoe requested a change in the minutes around Kirwee Recreation Reserve bins.

Mrs Pascoe requested that minutes be circulated within three days after a meeting so that Board members have the information at hand. She noted there was a statutory requirement for this to happen. The Board Secretary agreed to talk to the Chief Executive about this matter and report back to the Board.

Actions from Previous Meeting

The Board received an updated actions sheet.

Mr Woods clarified further his request about responsibility for water leakage costs where the source was not found.

He told the Board about the example he had where a water race was originally used for house water. When a water supply was put in it was coupled to the pipe and buried it under the water race. Over time the pipe developed a leak, and the water leaking didn't rise to the surface and the water was running into the water race. The water meter reading was seven times the normal average 6 monthly bill. Mr Washington said there was a Council policy but if there was a special case staff would definitely look into it. He asked Mr Woods for the contact details of the case in order to follow up.

Mr May asked about the pipe by the Kirwee Hall which had apparently ruptured where it came out of the concrete and has been leaking for probably a number of years. Mr Washington would follow up on the matter.

Mr Woods then raised the matter of his decision not to represent the Board on community committees. He referenced several previous discussions in this regard. Mr Woods then told the Board it was his opinion that he would after all be comfortable serving on those committees. After a lengthy discussion Board members agreed that Mr Woods would be free to serve on committees but would delay any action on this matter until the end of June when Council has made further decisions about the future of community committees.

Footpath to Roecombe Road, western end of Sheffield, next to the domain, overgrown, with no safety rails by the culvert – can it be looked at for improvement?

There was a complaint about the Glentunnel Hall booking for ANZAC Day, noting there was another booking at noon. He asked that staff look at the timing in-between events so that there was a good period of time to clean up.

Lake Coleridge – design and feasibility study of stormwater mitigation works underway. When can design work be expected.

Can staff clarify whether Discretionary Funds come from targeted rates or Council supplies as this will determine the future of Discretionary Funds.

Taken as read with the Chair noting he was aware of negative comments about the drop-in session at Springfield and the fact that it presumably stopped trade for the café with the comment that a Council building or hall be used instead. The Chair explained the reason behind using a café saying if there wasn't one available, of course the Board would use a hall.

Mrs Meares asked about maintenance of spouting and gutters and Mr Washington said it was the responsibility of the Council property team. In terms of broken rubbish in lids or pins, Mrs Meares was told anyone with a complaint could ring Council and these would be replaced.

Taken as read, with Mrs Pascoe enquiring about the process for transitioning of Hall and Reserve committees to becoming Community committees. The example she quoted was of the Greendale and Kimberley committees which were the only committees who take an interest in their communities. Were they to be disbanded there would be no-one to do what they currently do. The question was asked whether these Hall Committees could transition to being a Community committee so they can still have a say. Mrs Pascoe asked whether there was an opportunity to form project committees and said Kirwee Committee was one year into a very complicated three or four year project. If the committee was to be dissolved it will leave much of the project up in the air.

The Chair commented that Council should not discount the commitment and contribution of community committees and as committees will probably not be available or existing in future, does that necessarily mean the outcome would not be quite as efficient.

- Springfield is trialling a new membrane filtration system.
- Darfield new bore being established in Creyke Road, also upgrading existing bore with UV.
- Kirwee new bore on Hoskyns Road and upgrading existing bore.
- Looking at options around Sheffield and Hororata for greater water capacity.
- Looking at getting increased consent for Hororata scheme.

Waste water

- Castle Hill waste water pond relining should be finished by early June.
- Darfield to Pines pipeline design and pricing being finalised, and is a LTP consultation issue.
