#### RECOMMENDATION

'That the Selwyn Central Discretionary Funds Committee grant \$4,000.00 from the Selwyn Central Ward Discretionary Fund to Selwyn MotorFest Inc to assist with the costs of the Selwyn Motorfest and Family Fun Day to be held on 22 November 2020'

#### 1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this report is to provide information to assist with the decision to recommend a grant.

#### 2. SIGNIFICANCE ASSESSMENT/COMPLIANCE STATEMENT

No significance issues identified.

#### 3. HISTORY/BACKGROUND

The Selwyn Motorfest has been held since 2017. It has become the premier motor show in Selwyn District allowing motoring enthusiasts to display their vehicles to the public.

It also provides the opportunity for community groups to raise funds by either assisting with running the event or having stalls to sell products to those attending.

Members of the pubic from the Selwyn Central and wider areas have the opportunity to view the display of vehicle and machinery on display and participate in the associated activities.

All profits are returned to the community.

The cost of running the event is estimated to be \$18,600.00.

A grant of \$5,000.00 is sought towards advertising costs, provision of hand cleaning stations and signage relating to Covid 19 control.

#### 4. PROPOSAL

Staff believe a grant is appropriate in this case as the event is significant for the Selwyn District as it attracts large crowds and supports local organisations.

It is recommended therefore that a grant of \$4,000.00 be approved.

A grant of \$3,500.00 was approved in July 2018 from the Selwyn Event Fund.

An application for funding for this year's event has also been made to the Selwyn Community Fund. The Committee considering the application will be meeting on the morning of 24 June. The decision will be reported to the Selwyn Central Discretionary Funds Committee prior to its consideration of the application.
