3. PURPOSE

The purpose of this report is to provide information to assist with the decision to recommend a grant.

4. SIGNIFICANCE ASSESSMENT/COMPLIANCE STATEMENT

No significance issues identified.

5. HISTORY/BACKGROUND

The Rolleston Residents Garden Competition has been held since 2017. The last competition was in 2018 with the intention now for it to be held every two years.

The competition's aim is to encourage Rolleston residents to take pride in their properties and to help beautify Rolleston.

The cost of running the competition is estimated to be \$1,733.00.

This is made up of \$437.00 for engraving of cups and keepsakes, catering \$874.00, printing and stationery \$114.00, venue hire for prize presentations \$108.00, petrol vouchers for judges and photographer \$200.00.

It is hoped local businesses will provide sponsorship totalling \$700.00.

A grant of \$1,000.00 is sought.

6. PROPOSAL

Staff believe a grant is appropriate in this case as the project will beatify Rolleston and provide enjoyment for residents viewing the gardens.

Staff do not believe funding should be provided for catering costs or petrol vouchers.

It is recommended therefore that a grant of \$659.00 be approved.

A grant of \$700.00 was approved in February 2017 towards engraving costs while an application in August 2018 lapsed as the Discretionary Funds Committee was unable to reach agreement regarding the making of a grant.
