RECOMMENDATION

'That the Selwyn Central Discretionary Funds Committee grant \$1360 from the Selwyn Central Ward Discretionary Fund to the Rolleston Girl Guides and Rangers, to assist with the costs of attending the attending the Girl Guiding New Zealand 2022 national jamboree "Journey 2022" on the 8th -15th January 2021.'

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this report is to provide information to assist with the decision to recommend a grant.

2. SIGNIFICANCE ASSESSMENT/COMPLIANCE STATEMENT

No significance issues identified.

3. HISTORY/BACKGROUND

Twenty-one members of the Rolleston Girl Guiding community are attending the Girl Guiding New Zealand 2022 national jamboree "Journey 2022". The group consists of twelve Girl Guides, four Rangers, six leaders, and one parent helper. Journey 2022 is being held in Mystery Creek, Hamilton. Our group plans to travel together to Auckland, and then transfer to Mystery Creek using transportation provided by Girl Guiding New Zealand. Jamboree costs \$995 for Guides, \$1150-\$1322.20 for Rangers and \$350 for Adults. Jamboree has been designed to go ahead in 2022 under Level 2 guidelines (1500 Guides will be split into 15 sub camps, and 700 Rangers will be split into 7 sub camps). This 7 day event is the penultimate guiding experience. Application is for support for travel costs associated with getting to Journey 2022. Fees have been paid; fundraising outlined below is for travel component only.

Girl Guiding New Zealand and Jamboree is about empowering young girls to grow into health young women. Many of our Rangers and older Guides are already volunteering in the community as helpers at Brownies and Pippins and each girl has a service component as part of their progression badges. Our girls attend six local schools between them and are involved in numerous cultural and sporting pursuits in the area. These strong, intelligent girls are the future leaders of our community.

Twenty One Members reside in the Selwyn District

One member resides in the Malvern ward, nineteen reside in the Selwyn central ward and one in the Springs ward.

The total cost of the trip is \$6,877

Fundraising from Bingo night, raffles and red zone colour run will amount to \$2,850

A grant of \$4,027 is sought.

4. PROPOSAL

The standard grant for teams involving three or more members is \$1,500.

Staff support a grant being made as it will assist in the personal development of the pupils involved. A grant of \$71.50 per pupil is supported by staff based on Twenty One members.

A grant of \$1,358.50 from the Selwyn Central Ward Discretionary Fund is therefore recommended

The Malvern Community Board and the Springs Ellesmere Discretionary fund Committee will be given the same recommendation at their next meetings.

5. OPTIONS

Option 1 That the Selwyn Central Discretionary Funds Committee grant \$1360 from the Selwyn Central Ward Discretionary Fund to the Rolleston Girl Guides and Rangers, to assist with the costs of attending the Girl Guiding New Zealand 2022 national jamboree "Journey 2022" on the 8th -15th January 2021.

Option 2 That the Selwyn Central Discretionary Funds Committee decline the application.

Staff recommend Option 1.
