RECOMMENDATION

'That the Selwyn Central Discretionary Funds Committee grant \$978 from the Selwyn Central Ward Discretionary Fund to assist with the costs of the Rolleston Residents Gardening Competition having their competition on the 17th and 18th of October 2022.'

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this report is to provide information to assist with the decision to recommend a grant.

2. SIGNIFICANCE ASSESSMENT/COMPLIANCE STATEMENT

No significance issues identified.

3. HISTORY/BACKGROUND

The Rolleston Residents Garden Competition is a competition in Rolleston for people to have their gardens judged over two days on 17 and 18 October 2022 to see whose garden is the best. It is the goal to continue the Council's initiative with the Rolleston Residents Garden Competition. This encourages people living in Selwyn/Rolleston to take pride in their properties and to help beautify Rolleston. We hold two judging days that involve six judges and two photographers that we provide petrol, morning tea and lunch. We then hold a prize-giving for the eleven competition categories. This involves hiring a space, a speaker, cups, prizes, and supper. This is estimated to cost \$1,478. This will let the group of volunteers continue to help build the community in Rolleston with the common Goal and incentive of gardening and taking pride in their gardens.

Fundraising have been undertaken to reduce the cost by going to local businesses and have received \$500 as support.

A grant of \$978 is sought.

4. PROPOSAL

There is no standard grant for community events.

Staff support a grant being made as it will assist in the community with local events bringing people of Selwyn together.

A grant of \$978 from the Selwyn Central Ward Discretionary Fund is therefore recommended.

'That the Selwyn Central Discretionary Funds Committee grant \$225 from the Selwyn Central Ward Discretionary Fund to assist with the costs of the Selwyn Women's Issue Group having their five meetings during the 2022 year.'

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this report is to provide information to assist with the decision to recommend a grant.

2. SIGNIFICANCE ASSESSMENT/COMPLIANCE STATEMENT

No significance issues identified.

3. HISTORY/BACKGROUND

We would like support with the hire costs of the Rolleston Community Centre for the five times a year that we meet. We are a group of elderly women that have limited funds and we have cut back the amount of times that we meet to be able to make the day an affordable one as our attendance began to drop due to the cost involved. We support the local community with many of our initiatives such as safety jackets in the local schools. We appreciate your consideration regarding this application.

This is a place where all women of Selwyn can meet and network together. We have bi-monthly meetings that are attended by about fifty of our members. These meetings have two speakers who speak about current issues that are of interest to our local senior women. It is a positive initiative that has served the Rolleston and wider Selwyn community for 25 year this year! We have continued to support high vis safety jackets for primary school children in the Selwyn area to keep local children safe on our roads. We approach and build relationship with local business to sponsor this initiative and local schools to partner with these businesses.

Estimated costs of the hall hires, speakers, morning tea and lunch catering and administration cost are estimated to be \$6,600. Money is raised by charging individuals to attend the day at \$20 per day with an average of 50 attendees and times the five meeting dates is estimated to earn \$5,000.

A grant of \$900 is sought.

4. PROPOSAL

There is no standard grant for community events.

Staff support a grant being made as it will assist in the district with local events bringing women of Selwyn together. The Grant has been put forward to all the Discretionary funds as this application is aimed at all women in Selwyn. Therefore a grant of \$225 per ward is supported by Staff per ward.

A grant of \$225 from the Selwyn Central Ward Discretionary Fund is therefore recommended.

The same recommendation will be put to the Springs and Ellesmere Discretionary Fund Committee and the Malvern Community Board.

5. OPTIONS

- Option 1 That the Selwyn Central Discretionary Funds Committee grant \$225 from the Selwyn Central Ward Discretionary Fund to assist with the costs of the Selwyn Women's Issue Group having their five meetings during the 2022 year.
- Option 2 That the Selwyn Central Discretionary Funds Committee decline the application.

Staff recommend Option 1.
