'That the Selwyn Central Discretionary Funds Committee grant \$785 from the Selwyn Central Ward Discretionary Fund to assist with the costs of the West Melton Gym Club to help send their coach's to training sessions to upskill them to be able to help the gymnastics the best they can.'

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this report is to provide information to assist with the decision to recommend a grant.

2. SIGNIFICANCE ASSESSMENT/COMPLIANCE STATEMENT

No significance issues identified.

3. HISTORY/BACKGROUND

The West Melton Gymnastics Club Incorporated is an amateur sports club affiliated to Gymnastics New Zealand and offers recreational artistic gymnastics and trampolining classes to children in the Selwyn area. There is membership of girls and boys ranges in age from pre-schoolers to late teens. What makes our club unique is its community feel and the passion of our coaches. The gym would like to upskill the coaches with some relevant courses provided by Gymnastics New Zealand. Please refer to our application and supporting documents for more information. The training will ensure the gymnasts are getting the best possible coaching to benefit their physical and emotional wellbeing.

The total costs of the training for the coaching are estimated to be \$785.

A grant of \$785 is sought.

4. PROPOSAL

Staff support a grant being made as it will assist in the personal development of the coaches involved and they will help the personal development of the Gymnasts and help them extend their sporting ability.

A grant of \$785 from the Selwyn Central Ward Discretionary Fund is therefore recommended.

'That the Selwyn Central Discretionary Funds Committee grant \$231 from the Selwyn Central Ward Discretionary Fund to the Lincoln High School Girls 1st XI Hockey Team, to assist with the costs of attending the 2022 Federation Cup Hockey Tournament to be held in Hastings from 28 August to 3 September 2022.'

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this report is to provide information to assist with the decision to recommend a grant.

2. SIGNIFICANCE ASSESSMENT/COMPLIANCE STATEMENT

No significance issues identified.

3. HISTORY/BACKGROUND

The Lincoln High School Girls 1st XI Hockey Team will attend the Federation Cup Hockey Tournament, to be held in Hastings from 28 August 2022- 3 September 2022.

The Federation Cup is the highest level of School Hockey and they are excited to be a part of the cup after winning the Audry Timlan Tournament in 2019 to qualify to play in the tournament – the first time ever for Lincoln High School. (2020 and 2021 tournament delayed due to Covid).

Sixteen pupils and four adults will be attending.

Ten are resident in Springs Ward and Three in Selwyn Central Ward and Three live outside Selwyn.

The cost of accommodation, travel, and sundry costs to attend is \$27,100.

Team and individual fundraising will be undertaken through honey wrap sales, salami sales, and user fees \$21,200.

A grant of \$1,000 is sought.

4. PROPOSAL

The standard grant for teams involving three or more members is \$1,500.

Staff support a grant being made as it will assist in the personal development of the pupils involved and help them extend their sporting ability. A grant of \$77 per pupil is supported by staff based on thirteen members.

A grant of \$231 from the Selwyn Central Discretionary Fund is therefore recommended.

The Springs Ellesmere Discretionary Funds Committee will consider this application with the same recommendation (\$77 per pupil) at its meeting on 25 May.

5. OPTIONS

Option 1 That the Selwyn Central Discretionary Funds Committee grant \$231 from the Selwyn Central Ward Discretionary Fund to the Lincoln High School Girls 1st XI Hockey Team, to assist with the costs of attending the 2022 Federation Cup Hockey Tournament to be held in Hastings from 28 August to 3 September 2022.

Option 2 That the Selwyn Central Discretionary Funds Committee decline the application.

Staff recommend Option 1.
