Agenda items

1. Electoral Commission and Voting

The Electoral Commission came in to speak with the Selwyn Youth Council about voting in the elections and encouraging young people to enroll. The youth advocates also provided resources that could be shared on social media. It is important that the youth council remain politically neutral but they are able to promote enrolments and voting in general.

Youth council members spoke National, Labour and Greens candidates are all available to do a speaking event if it is something the youth council might consider hosting. There is risk in terms of political neutrality with a candidate's event, however, there was an option of creating a podcast for MPs to come in and answer questions relevant to young people in Selwyn. A word document is to be created to formulate these questions.

ACTION / OUTCOME

- Youth councilors to vote in poll about who is to lead the podcast interviews
- Digital Marketing Apprentices to share resources on Facebook and Instagram

2. Council Report

3. Survey

5. Project 3 Team Update

Under the name BOOST Give Back, the following is being organized and/or supported by the project team and wider youth council:

- A planting day on Sunday 6th September to welcome international students, newcomers and migrants. Youth councilors to invite a international student from each high school.
- A Keep NZ Beautiful Clean Up Day which includes cleaning up the community, parks and reserves. More
 information and dates to come but likely to be held the weekend after the planting day on either Saturday
 12th or Sunday 13th September. Poll to go up on Facebook for those interested in helping.
- Youth councilors to volunteer at a local food bank; dates to follow.

• Older volunteers in the community to be interviewed about why they volunteer and why they give back to the community.

ACTION / OUTCOME

- Polls to be created on Facebook and those who do not have Facebook to email through interest to Shay.
- Project team to meet again to discuss Keep NZ Beautiful clean ups.
- Shay to confirm dates and times for volunteering at the food banks.
- 2 or 3 older volunteers to be identified to be interviewed.

6. Selwyn Young Leaders Day

This was an event supported by the Selwyn Youth Council through the Youth Project Fund. Jeremy and Shay attended this in July to promote Selwyn Youth Council and raise awareness for elections in November this year. Erana also recorded a podcast with the Two Raw sisters at the event which will be posted on Spotify in the coming weeks.

7. Selwyn Community Fund Committee

Selwyn youth councilors to have representatives on the committee. Emma and Issy to participate in the July round.

ACTION / OUTCOME

• Shay to get in contact with Emma and Issy and connect with Council funding coordinators.

8. Creative Communities

The Creative Community Fund is like the SYC fund group, except they are specifically funding creative events. Amazing events have happened though the funding of this group.

ACTION / OUTCOME

9. Boost Spook

Youth council members to try and come along as it's a team experience. Also, if you can, bring friends to volunteer on the day too. The BOOST Spook Project Team needs to be established with 'champions' to lead the organization of the event.
